BECK

Californian alternative icon and pop polymath Beck experiments with genres and has an approach to style so fluid that the only thing one could expect from a new record is that it would be different from the last. The ubiquity of his 1994 lo-fi rap/folk slacker anthem “Loser” pointed toward one-hit-wonder status, but those predictions were punctured by the boundary-pushing work that quickly followed. Far from the short-lived novelty act his early success might have suggested, Beck continued down his unique and ever-winding path for decades, taking on new forms with every release.



LANA DEL REY

American singer-songwriter Lana Del Rey, born Elizabeth Woolridge Grant, rose to international prominence with her 2011 viral single, “Video Games,” and the critically acclaimed album *Born to Die* (2012). Known for her atmospheric, cinematic sound and husky vocals, Del Rey has established a unique artistic identity built on themes of tragic romance, classic Americana, and nostalgic Hollywood glamour. Her influence extends beyond music, shaping modern aesthetics and pop culture. With a catalog of chart-topping and culturally significant albums, including *Ultraviolence* (2014) and *Did You Know That There's a Tunnel Under Ocean Blvd* (2023), she has garnered multiple Grammy nominations.



TYLER RAMSEY

Tyler Ramsey is a fingerstyle guitarist and a captivating voice in modern indie folk, based outside of Asheville, North Carolina. Tyler has released a series of critically acclaimed solo albums, including “For the Morning” (2019), which showcased his signature blend of fingerpicked guitar, pedal steel, and atmospheric rock textures, and “New Lost Ages” (2024), produced by Phil Ek (Fleet Foxes, The Shins). Last month, Tyler and My Morning Jacket guitarist Carl Broemel announced their full-length collaboration album “Celestun” (out Jan. 15, 2026).



MUIREANN BRADLEY

This is my first album. Most of these tunes were originally recorded by the great blues men and women who were making records from the 1920s and 1930s right up in some cases to the early 1970s. Each individual track on this album was recorded live in the studio and represents one entire take with me singing and backing myself up on guitar simultaneously. Nothing has been added or taken away, no overdubs or modern recording tricks of any kind have been used at all so at least in some respects this album has been recorded in the same way as those classics of the 1920s and 1930s. I hope you enjoy the record.



MASANGA MARIMBA

Masanga Marimba plays traditional and popular music from Africa and Latin America. The instruments used in this ensemble consist of 7 Zimbabwean marimbas of various sizes along with vocals, drums, percussion, saxophone and trumpet. The word “Masanga” comes from an African word that means the coming together of rivers or roads representing the meeting of African, Latin and American traditions in this group. Their music is upbeat, danceable, and family-oriented.
