

3D Butterfly Craft

Supplies needed: Construction paper, scissors, glue or tape, markers, googly eyes, pipe cleaners

- Print and color the attached wing template. Or you can trace the wings onto a colored piece of construction paper
- 2. Print and color the body pieces, or trace them onto colored paper.
- 3. Put a small amount of glue or tape on one end of each body piece.
- 4. Fold the strips into a circle, overlapping the ends and gluing or taping them together.







- 5. Glue or tape the center of the butterfly wings to a piece of paper.
- 6. Make sure to leave the outside of the wings unattached. Fold them up to give the butterfly a 3D look





- 7. Cut a pipe cleaner in half to make your butterfly's antenna. Glue, or tape, them to the top of the wings.
- 8. Curl the tops of the antenna










- 9. Glue or tape your body pieces to the center of the wings, seam side down.
- 10. Add designs to the wings. You can cut and paste on different shapes, or draw directly on the wings.
- 11. Add eyes and a face if you'd like!
