



DIY Crown

*Materials: Pencil / Pen / Crayon / Marker /
Colored Pencils, Tape or Glue, Scissors, and Paper*



4 years +



15+ Minutes



2+ People

Children under the age of 7 may need the assistance of a caregiver



1. **Choose a crown template!** You can find tons of ideas [here](#) or go to the last page of this document for an example.
2. **Print out your template OR draw your own crown design** (you can use the templates for inspiration but draw your own if you don't have a printer or if you'd like to add your own touch)!
3. **Cut out your crown.**
4. **Tape or glue the pieces together**, but don't connect it all the way around just yet.
5. **Decorate your crown!** Get creative, draw fun patterns, add some glitter, and use any materials you can find!
6. **Glue the ends together.** Measure the crown around your head. Trim the ends to achieve the right length before gluing the ends of the bands together. Then, try on your crown!

Reflection Questions:

1. What kind of crown did you create: queen, king, prince, princess, superhero, fairy, etc. (it could be ANYTHING! Think outside of the box)?
2. Give yourself a new title based on the type of crown you decided on. Example: Anna the Ocean Fairy or Jace the Prince of Atlantis.
3. What do you think would be the most exciting part of being whoever you decided in the question above?
4. If you lived in a magical land, what would you call it? What would it look like?
5. In this new land, what is one rule that you would create that everyone would have to follow?
6. What do you think a typical day in your new land would look like?
7. You can give yourself one magical power, what is it and why did you choose it?
