How to Apply Guide:

Camp at Home Session

- 1. Please log into our camper database, CampSite
 - a. Return Families: Log In to your existing CampSite account here
- 2. Select the main camper Click on the "Enroll for 2022" below your camper's name to begin the application.
- 3. Complete each page of the application.

If an effort to simplify registration for Camp at Home, there is one application for the entire family. You do not need to add or enroll each family member. You'll enter each family member's information on a form after enrolling just the main camper.



a. Enrollment Options: Choose the "Camp at Home" session

If you are choosing **Camp at Home**, select which session you are enrolling (applying for). Remember to click "Save and continue" at the bottom of the screen. (Leave the passcode field empty, as this is not needed)

- b. Questions: Answer all questions and click "Save and continue" at the bottom of the screen. When it asks who the enrollment for, select Child with the Medical Condition. You will fill in information for all other family members participating on a different form as you'll see below.
- c. **Forms:** Complete the forms.

For Camp at Home, there are 3 forms... Policies, Registration Form and Authorization and Release Form. If you had previously applied for a camp session this year, you may see additional forms. Please disregard those for now and only complete the ones mentioned above. (You can also ignore the authorized pickup box) Click "Save & Continue: to checkout at the bottom of the screen.

d. **Checkout:** Sign and click the "Submit Enrollment" request button. Acceptances for each session will be sent out as soon as possible, on a rolling basis.
