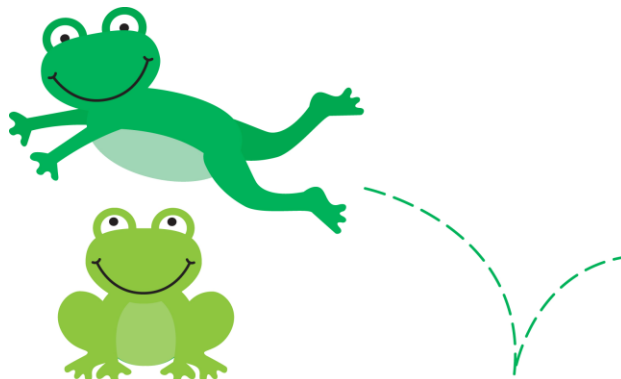


Scan the QR code below to watch a YouTube tutorial on how to make an origami frog.



Make a squad of frogs and set them off to the races. Use the attached square sheet of paper, or make your own square out of colored paper, to make your frog. Add eyeballs, patterns, colors, tongues, and whatever else you think a frog needs to be speedy! Challenge a family member or nurse to a frog race across the table.

Need to make a square out of rectangular paper? --->



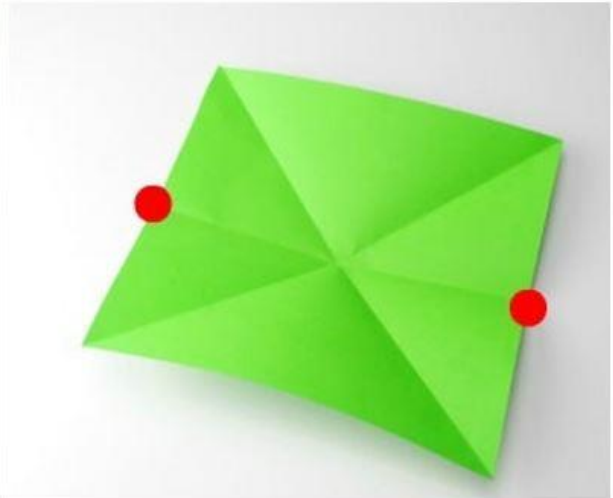

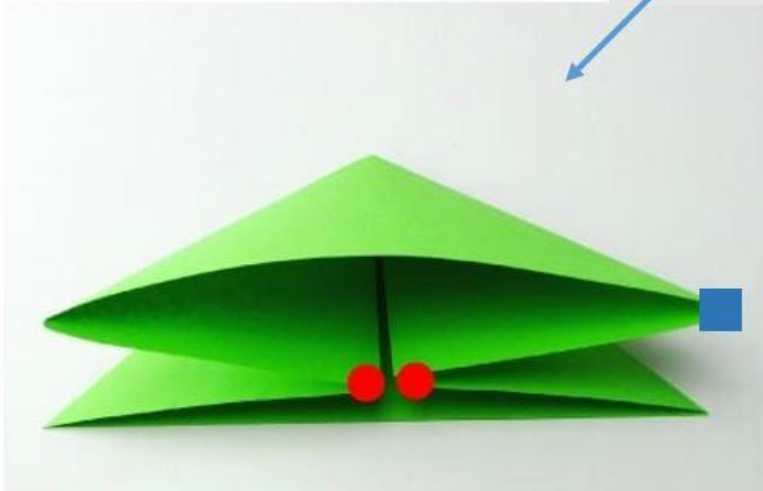
Cut, or fold and tear, the dotted line above so you have a square sheet of paper to construct a frog



Fold your square in half diagonally in both directions



Fold the parts marked with dots toward the center so it matches the below picture



Fold the corner, marked with a square, to the top. Repeat on the left side



Fold the corner, marked with a dot, to the middle. Repeat on left side



Your paper should now look like this!

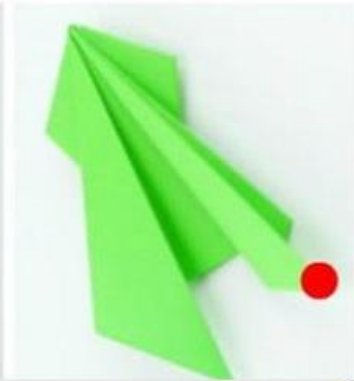


Flip your frog over, you should now see a large triangle. Fold the corner, marked with a square, down and toward the middle. Your frog should now look like the bottom right picture.

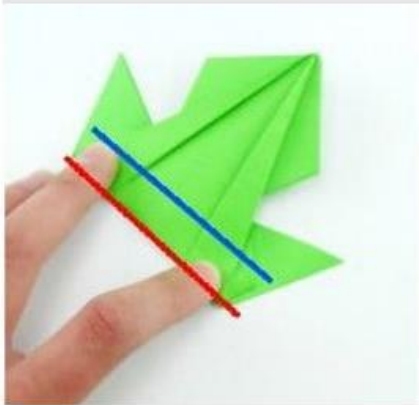
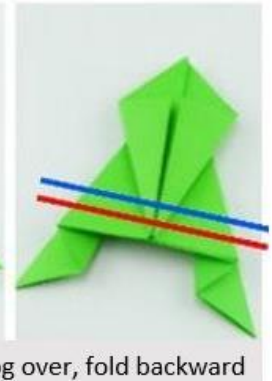




Fold the corner, marked with a dot, outwards. Repeat on other side.



Flip your frog over, fold backward along the red (bottom) line.



Flip your frog once more, and fold forward along the blue (top) line.



Your frog is complete! Give it eyes, a tongue, spots or whatever you want and send it to the races!
