As a volunteer Physical or Occupational Therapist at Camp you will play a large role in ensuring every aspect of Camp can be enjoyed by campers of every ability. Whether you are safely transferring campers into a boat or onto a horse, or supporting their climb on the ropes course, your day is sure to be packed full of fun as you help to create a safe and inclusive environment for all. All medical volunteers must be professionally licensed in California and have at least one year of clinical work experience.

Spring & Fall Family Weekends:

Family Weekends are a 3-4 day commitment.

Volunteers arrive Friday afternoon at 1pm and depart Sunday afternoon.

Summer Sessions:

Summer Sessions are a 6-7 day commitment.

Volunteers arrive the day before the session begins for training and depart the last day of Camp.
