Supplies Needed:

- 10 Sheets of Paper
- String
- Glue or Tape
- Scissors
- Markers / Crayons / Colored Pencils



A helpful video to walk you through it!

Step 1:

Fold the first piece of paper in half (fold it from top to bottom, "hamburger" style). Draw a triangle on the paper, the point of the triangle will meet on the edge of the paper that is not folded. Cut the triangle out, you now have 2 triangles connected by the folded edge of the paper. Repeat until you have the desired number of triangles for your bunting. *When deciding how many triangles you'll need, think of a word you want to spell out!)*



Step 2:

Lay out your string, no need to cut it yet. Open the first triangle - you'll have a diamond shape, and put the string in the middle of the crease (see below). Take glue or tape and place a small amount of it just below the string. Fold the triangle to close. Repeat until all triangles have been added, leave a small amount of space between each one.



Step 3:Decorate triangles and cut the end of your string. Spell out a word, draw pictures, add some color, or create a pattern (or do it all)! You now have a festive banner you can hang anywhere!
