
Meet Evan: a ten-year-old first-time camper! This summer, he tuned in to Camp at Homefrom his hospital bed. Evan was diagnosed with pseudo-obstruction in his small intestine in March of 2014, and he is on TPN (total parenteral nutrition) for 13 hours per day. He was recently hospitalized for over two weeks due to an infection of his central line.

The joy of Camp offered some reprieve during a challenging time, both for Evan and his family who joined him. "Camp was a great experience for my son to try new things and

realize there are other kids who are on TPN or have other health conditions," said Evan's mother, Christine. "He's been hospitalized many times since 2013. Participating in the virtual Camp was a refreshing change for him." Outpost Delivers

The Outpost team has been hard at work delivering the magic of Camp into hospitals and clinics throughout California, virtually! Since postponing all in-person programming, Outpost has served campers and caregivers by facilitating Virtual Playroom activity sessions at UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital Oakland and by mailing 6,967 bedside bags full of activities to 20 hospitals and clinics. These initiatives have allowed Outpost to extend their reach to new locations they previously were unable to serve in person.

Teresa Molello, Hospital Outreach Manager for The Painted Turtle, shares this sweet story: "A particularly spunky 5-year-old had wide eyes as she pulled each item out of her activity bag and said 'There is SO much stuff in here! Can I do it all?!' At one point something clicked in her brain and she asked the other kids on the Zoom call, "Wait, you're all in the hospital too?!' Because of COVID, the kids aren't allowed to leave their rooms during their stay, so it's nice for them to realize they aren't the only ones in the hospital. Virtual Outpost for the win!"
