Summary:

The Painted Turtle seeks an energetic and passionate individual for the position of Volunteer Associate. This is a full-time, contract position from March to August 15th. The ideal candidate is a highly motivated team player with the ability to work autonomously when necessary and who possesses strong organizational, managerial, interpersonal, and communication skills. The Volunteer Associate will work as a team with a second Volunteer Associate and the Volunteer Coordinator in processing, supporting, supervising, and encouraging full integration of volunteers in all aspects of camp programming. This role involves maintaining a high level of correspondence across multiple deadlines and coordinating arrival/departure logistics for all summer volunteers.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

• Volunteer Administration

- Processing, selection, and transportation of all volunteers as part of a team.
- Assist with updating and maintaining volunteer database after each session to ensure proper demographics and profiles are up-to-date.
- Preparing and compiling necessary paperwork including end of session needs, program evaluations, and special requests.
- Serve as an additional resource for volunteer communication prior to volunteers' arrival at camp.

• Volunteer Training and Arrival

 Assist Volunteer Coordinator with volunteer arrival and orientation each session, including preparing arrival paperwork, facilitating orientation, and overseeing summer staff who are assisting with volunteer orientation.

• Volunteer Support and Supervision

- Participate in volunteer check-in system to provide continued support of volunteers throughout the session.
- Assist with planning and implementing summer season volunteer appreciation plan.
- Overall awareness of volunteer performance throughout the session to ensure proper performance evaluation of volunteers and reporting concerns to Volunteer Coordinator.

• Other

- Serve as a member of the seasonal Support Team and assist in the coordination and implementation of on-site operations including but not limited to: on-site programming, staff training, volunteer/staff appreciation, etc.
- Manages a high volume of correspondence
- Completes other duties as assigned by the Volunteer Coordinator, Camp Director, and other full-time leadership team members.

- Volunteer or work experience in a children's camp environment preferred, supervisory experience a plus
- Minimum high school diploma or GED education
- Skilled in PC computer operations including word processing, database management, and internet access; familiarity with Google suite and Microsoft Office suite

- Ability to manage multiple deadlines
- Ability to work independently and within a team environment
