



Wrapped Headphones

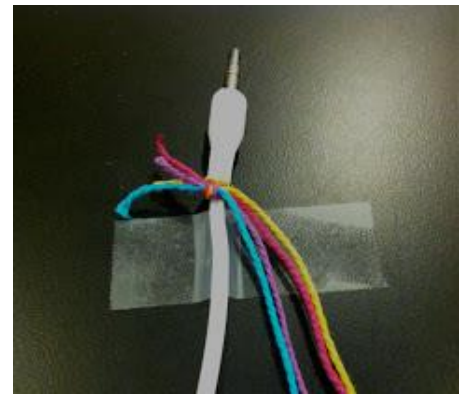
Supplies needed: headphones, embroidery thread, scissors



1. Select the thread colors you would like to use. Wrap the headphones in one color, in a pattern, ombre style, or in a rainbow of colors! Cut the thread longer than the headphone cord you will be wrapping, you'll need more than you think.

**tip* use a piece of tape to attach your cord to a table or bed sheet so it's easier to work with*

2. Knot your colors around your cord, close to the plug.
3. Grab one string, the color you'd like to be first, and create a "4 knot". Make a 4 with your thread by pulling it to the right and then crossing over the cord and remaining colors. Loop the end of the thread through the 4 and pull up towards the top to create the knot (be sure to incorporate your loose ends where you tied your threads into your wrapping).
4. Continue making "4 knots" to create a colored section as big/small as you want.
5. Repeat with each color to create your desired pattern.
6. When you reach a split, or microphone/volume controls, tie off and cut your threads. Repeat steps 2-4 on the other side of the split and continue your pattern.



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You can also do this with a charging cord
